 - Members > Advisory Committee (AC)
 - The W3C Team + Advisory Board (AB) + Technical Architecture Group (TAG)
- Progress: Working, Interest and Coordination Groups
 - Working Groups produce recommendation reports, software, test suites, and reviews of the deliverables of other groups.
 - Interest Groups bring together people who wish to evaluate potential Web technologies and policies.
 - Coordination Groups facilitate communication between groups, within or outside of W3C.
