## The Importance of Being Ernest

- Knowledge Empowers.
  Absolute Knowledge Empowers Absolutely.
- Scale changes the problem *qualitatively*. Structured abstractions are the only hope.
- The discipline of Ontology leads to clarity in design.
- Text is insufficient.
  - It does not reliably denote the content, much less the context of interpretation or the relations to other work.
  - Much content (audio, video, pictures) has no text at all.
  - Specific types of especially important concepts (e.g., events, processes, achievements, etc.) that are necessary for advanced applications are inaccessible in text.
- Semantic meta-language is the only means of capturing the user's perspective, intentions.
- Semantic structure supports validation and 'proof'.
- "It may not be perfect; it might be awkward; but it's better than the alternatives..." (evolution/engineering/NN) — J.McCarthy
