

## Hiwi – Job “Social Semantic Desktop – Services”

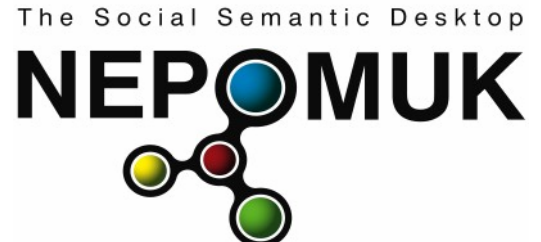
